Overview



Invoke-WebRequest



Sends a HTTP/S request to a web service

Result is returned as a PowerShell object

**Interacting with the web from a
command line**

Can create and maintain sessions

Common HTTP Methods

GET

POST

DELETE

PUT



REST

REpresentational State Transfer

Uses the HTTP protocol

- REST is not a protocol

REST server provides access to resources

Resources are identified by a Uniform Resource Identifier (URI)



Invoke-RestMethod



Sends a HTTP/S request to a RESTful web service

PowerShell formats the response based on the data type

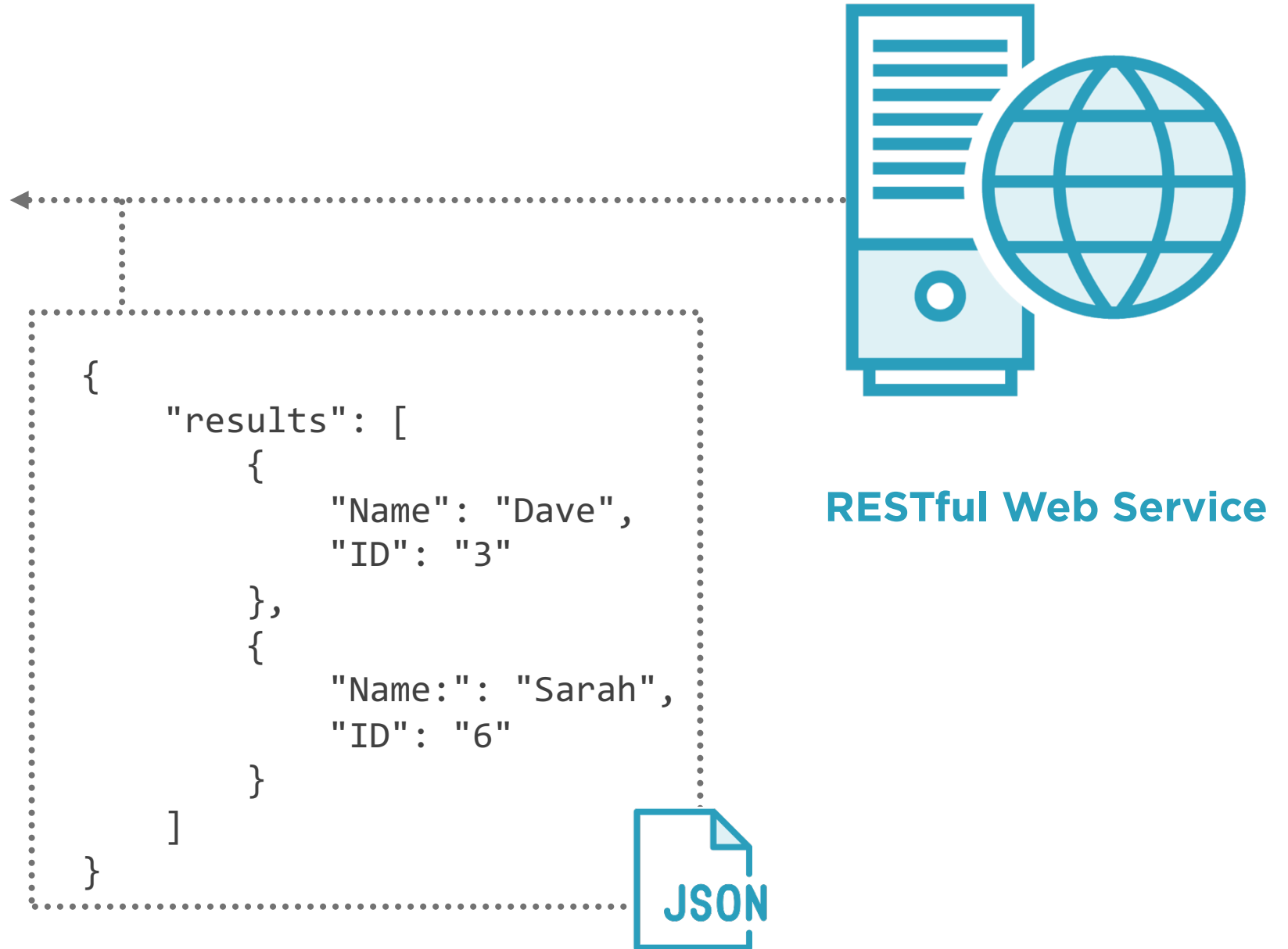

Invoke-RestMethod

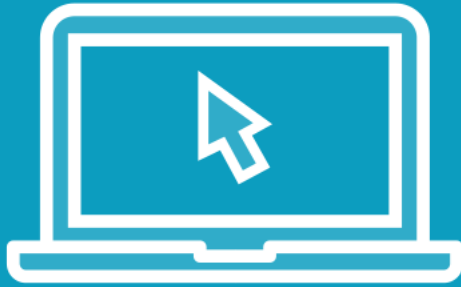
If you know you're working

massage the response



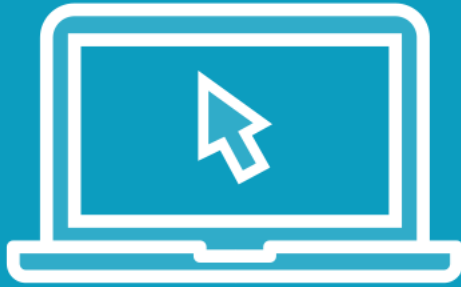
